PASTOR OR DIRECTOR OF MISSIONS

ACCOUNTABLE TO:

The Pastor or Director of Missions shall be accountable to the Senior Pastor of Eastminster Presbyterian Church.

OVERVIEW:

Eastminster Presbyterian Church is located in Wichita, Kansas, and is a congregation of 1500 members. As a missional church, we support local and global partners, send missionaries and cultivate in our membership a missional heart. Our motto is, "We all go, to the end of the street and to the ends of the earth." Our commitment to mission is reflective of our \$940,000 budget. Our mission efforts include both missionaries in challenging overseas environments and mission partners making a difference in our local community. There are 76 mission partners encouraged, cared for and overseen by our local and world councils. We encourage short-term mission trips both in our community and in our world. Eastminster members are deeply involved on the local level with the Congolese refugee community who worship at our church and with efforts to redeem the difficult neighborhoods in our city.

GOALS:

To create a missional heart in every member of the congregation. Our church indeed becomes the missionary, with our members engaged in the redemptive work of the gospel somewhere in Wichita or the world.

Oversee the administration of a mission effort, which includes 76 mission partners and a \$940,000 budget. Coordinate the mission work of the church, emphasizing those projects that are part of the vision of the church.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Lead, oversee and develop the mission program at Eastminster in cooperation with the mission elders, church staff and congregational teams. This involves significant administrative gifts.

Nurture and grow the missional heart of the church by developing events and educational opportunities. Meet with church members to help them find an area of personal mission focus.

Create and design mission outreach that connects church members to those in need of the gospel. Train congregants in this missional priority.

Prepare teams for short-term trips, ensuring that their short-term mission experience transforms their lives and helps create in them a missional heart.

METRICS:

The number of people doing mission at Eastminster increases in some way every year. This can be measured by participation in ministry, leadership, short-term trip experiences, and increased giving and focused prayer for missions.

Events and mission trips are smoothly planned, prepared and accomplished with excellence, positively impacting participants' lives.

The administrative work includes the support of all missionaries, integrated support of the Congolese church with the life of Eastminster, inner-city work coordinated with local partners and encouraging the mission vision of the church.

CHARACTER, EXPERIENCE & SKILL SET:

An abiding faith in Christ and commitment to prayer.

Demonstrates the fruit of the Spirit and a Reformed understanding of the scriptures.

A missional heart and experience in some aspect of mission work.

Administrative and organizational skills; able to multi-task while managing events, people and budgets.

Strategic thinking skills to visualize and plan how to enhance the missional heart in our people.

Leadership skills that challenge, motivate and recruit others to respond to God's call, encouraging involvement in mission both locally and in the world.

This position is an ordained or non-ordained position. Though a theological degree or MDiv is not required, the person applying for this position must be mature in their faith, have a solid understanding of the scriptures and be competent to teach and communicate biblical truth as it pertains to missions.
